

## **PYTHAGORAS (circa 580 to 500 BC)**

**exoterically** the Greek Philosopher, Mathematician and Educator who founded the **Pythagorean School** and from which began **Pythagoreanism**; and **esoterically** the **SCHOOL OF ON (ANNU)** Greek student **who undertook a 40 day VEGETARIAN fast to gain entrance**, who went on to found his **Pythagorean School** in Italy and promulgated his **ANNU CULTURE** education with theories on the **Celestial Music Harmony** and famous **Pythagorean Theory on the Hypotenuse of a Right Triangle** which was the prerequisite to building the **GREAT PYRAMIDS** done two thousand years before his birth and thus learned at the **SCHOOL OF ON (ANNU)**.
