Indiana Supreme Court Upholds Taking of 82 Year Old Afro and Native American Elder Louise E. Hall's \$550,000 Retirement Home and Investment Property with Phony Deed Without Appeal Because Her Son is Rastafarian

In May, 2005 the Indiana Supreme Court [CA Cause # 49A02-0505-CV-376] upheld the confiscation of 82 year old Black Indian Elder and retired Indianapolis IN. Public School Elementary Teacher Louise E. Hall's \$550,000 retirement home and investment property at 6135 Riverview Drive, Indianapolis, IN. 46208 she had owned and lived in for 39 year.

Mrs. Hall co-founded in 1995 BRCA, Inc. a federal grant and award winning non-profit *chronic poverty reduction* RD & D center. She has been the main benefactor of BRCA, Inc. which her son Rastafarian Priest George W. Singleton III directs as a non-denominational religious order. She has been stunned that in modern America an obvious Phony Deed concocted by errant ex-BRCA, Inc. Treasurer and Board Member [Edward Rogell, Santa Maria, CA.] and rejected by the Marion County Assessment Office would be upheld by the Indiana Supreme Court without appeal. Requests for help to US Senator Lugar's and US Representative Julia Carson's Offices, the Regional FBI Office and the Indian State Police were to no avail even though the use of a Phony Deed across state lines is a federal offence. Clearly, the Rastafarian religion of her son means he and she have no recognized legal, property and civil rights in America.

Having suffered in 1957 the death of her civil rights activist husband Dr. George W. Singleton, Jr., MD. in a KKK connected murder in Shelby NC. and cancer death of her second husband in 2004; Mrs. Hall must accept America has cycled into an oligarchy as Elders Kurt Vonnegut and Harry Belafonte have pointed out where the rich and powerful with lawyers can do what ever they want.

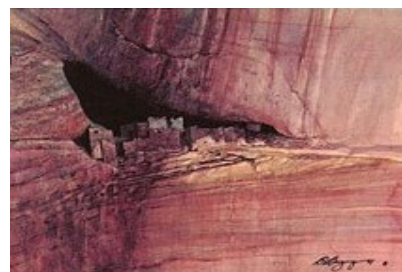
